
## **Create Your Own "Analyzing Visuals" Handout to use with Students**

**1.** Fill in the rectangles below to show the steps Carla (a fictitious student) took to create the diagram shown in Step 4 for the word problem: *Rita read 224 pages of a book. Rita still has 1/5 of the book left to read. How many pages are in the book?* 

To fill in the steps, consider what diagramming steps you want students to analyze to understand how to use a diagram to solve the word problem.
