The TODOS-Texas Instruments NCSM Student Recognition Awards are awarded to local area students from underrepresented groups who meet at least one of the following criteria:

- ~Demonstrated sustained success in mathematics;
- ~Shown significant progress in mathematics achievement;
- ~Has a specific “mathematics student success story: deserving of recognition (e.g. extraordinary project, overcome obstacles, etc.); or
- ~Has gone “above and beyond” in some aspect of his/her mathematics performance.
