Mathematics Assistant Professor (Two Positions)

The faculty member shall be responsible for the following: teaching assigned classes under the supervision of the area dean; being accessible to students by maintaining office hours; helping students fulfill their maximum potential in mastering course content; maintaining thorough and up-to-date knowledge in his/her regular teaching field; maintaining standards of professional conduct and ethics appropriate to the professional position; assisting with curriculum and articulation studies; serving on college committees and participating in faculty governance and student co-curricular activities; assuming other responsibilities as assigned by the area dean; fulfilling other duties and responsibilities as outlined in the college faculty handbook.

Additional Responsibilities:**Minimum Qualifications:**

1. Have a master's degree from an accredited institution in mathematics or applied mathematics completed by August 23, 2012; OR, bachelor's in either of the above AND master's in statistics, physics, or mathematics education; OR, hold a California Community College Instructor's Credential in the discipline area; OR, the equivalent. Note: Applicants applying under the "equivalent" provision must attach details and explain how their academic preparation is equivalent of the degree listed above.
2. Have sensitivity to and understanding of the diverse academic socioeconomic, cultural, disability and ethnic backgrounds of community

college students, including those with physical or learning disabilities as it relates to the differences in learning styles.
