

The Program in Mathematics Education in the College of Natural Science at Michigan State University is seeking one or more tenure-system faculty members at open rank (Assistant, Associate, or Full Professor). Successful candidates will have a joint appointment between the Program in Mathematics Education and either the Department of Mathematics or the Department of Statistics and Probability, with tenure home in one of the two departments. Outstanding candidates in any area of mathematics or statistics education are encouraged to apply. There is particular interest in candidates whose research focuses on college-level mathematics or statistics education. Successful candidates will join a large and vibrant mathematics education community at Michigan State University, including faculty members from the Colleges of Education and Natural Science, the highly-ranked doctoral program in Mathematics Education, and the Institute for Research in Mathematics and Science Education.

An earned doctorate, a strong background in mathematics or statistics, and a strong record of scholarship, commensurate with rank, are required. Candidates at the senior level are expected to have a successful record of externally-funded research projects, guidance of graduate students, and national leadership in mathematics or statistics education. All candidates are expected to have a record of, and commitment to, excellent teaching.

Review of applications will begin December 1, 2011 and continue until the positions are filled. Applicants should submit a letter of application that includes links to two representative publications or manuscripts, curriculum vitae, statements on research and teaching, and the names of four references, at least one of whom must address the applicant's teaching.
