We are soliciting applications for the 2008 TODOS Professional and Leadership Development Awards. This program addresses two of the goals of TODOS:

- To promote, provide and support programs that advance the professional growth of members and build leadership capacity.
- To provide grants for professional development opportunities in areas such as curriculum, instruction, assessment, equity, culture, language as they relate to the teaching and learning of mathematics.

Funds are designated for Scholarship Awards for at most *five* members to participate in professional development opportunities during the **2008 and 2009 calendar years**. Each Awardee will be provided financial support for an amount of **\$1,000 - \$1,500** for expenses. If actual expenses are less than the amount awarded, the reimbursement will be for the actual amount spent. Any expenses greater than the awarded amount will not be covered and will be the responsibility of the Awardee. After the event attended, reimbursement will be made on the basis of the submitted expense form and receipts for registration, travel, and lodging.

Awardees may attend professional development opportunities and/or conferences related to good mathematics for all whether they are found in mathematics and/or in bilingual education. Some possible opportunities include *but are not limited* to:

- 11th International Congress on Mathematics Education (ICME 11) in Monterrey, Mexico, July 6-13, 2008.
- Western NCSM Leadership Academy in Midway, Utah, July 15-18, 2008.
- Eastern NCSM Leadership Academy in Hunt Valley, Maryland, July 29 August 1, 2008.
- NABE (National Assoc. for Bilingual Education) in Austin, Texas, February 18-21, 2009.
- NCTM Regional Conferences in October & November, 2008.
- Mathematics or Bilingual Education Conferences held by state organizations or affiliates of NCTM and NABE.
- Summer programs and institutes for professional development or graduate work.
