Heising-Simons Award

TODOS received a two-year award of \$100,000 total from Heising-Simons in June 2021 to develop and strengthen its infrastructure to escalate its efforts to advocate for equity. H-S also funded a consultant to work with TODOS on organizational assessment and development. Efforts have been made in the following areas: moving *TEEM* to OJS, determining a publishing software license for TODOS, organizing TODOS recordings in Vimeo, updating and streamlining the website, discussing fund development ideas, creating a TODOS Conference Handbook as a guide for TODOS Conferences, and creating a Professional Development Handbook as a guide to provide PD for schools, districts, and other entities.
